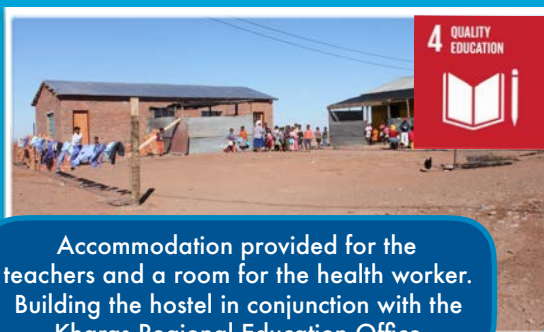

Improving Physical Activities for all learners. IIKhūta!hoas has constructed a sports pitch and 300m track. Funds to be provided to fence the areas and to purchase new sports equipment to provide a facility which the local school can use for interschool competitions




Winter Food Supplements for OVC's. Providing protein supplements for the orphans and vulnerable children in the hostel and Kindergarten







Invest in a Life Skills and Enterprise Development Programme for the School and Community




Purchase goats for the vulnerable families




onebillion one Class project for using apps to help teach basic numeracy and literacy for the 'learners' using tablets. A set of iPads, headphones & lockable charging unit will be provided

Collect secondhand brass instruments for the school band to help build self-confidence and teamwork in the learners




Support the Pre Primary School Classes by painting murals on the classroom walls linked to the curriculum. Purchase pre-school literature, toys, playground equipment and blankets
